



RUSSIA NORTHERN LIGHT

Day 01 : Arrive Moscow. {Meals: Dinner}

Arrive Moscow international airport by any convenient flight. Meet on arrival and transfer to hotel {Check-in time 2 PM}. Evening plan to enjoy evening Cruise Ride at Moskva River. Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

Night stay in hotel.

Day 02 : Moscow. (Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and dinner)

Today post breakfast experience Moscow's Kremlin, the heart of the city, on a private half-day walking tour. Wander among this fortified complex to see the legendary churches of Cathedral Square & marvel at the Grand Kremlin Palace—home to approximately 4,000 artifacts dating all the way back to the 12th- century. Look for the works of Russian goldsmiths and silversmiths, Catherine the Great's coronation dress and even an ivory throne once belonging to Ivan the Terrible.



Red Square is just outside the Kremlin's walls. While walking on Red Square you will admire the Mausoleum of Lenin, the clock on the Savior (Spasskaya) Tower - showing the most correct Moscow time, the History Museum, the beautiful Cathedral of the Intercession (the Church of St Basil the Blessed), Kazansky Cathedral and many other outstanding pieces of Russian architecture.



Visit Arbat, Moscow's most famous pedestrian street, in the company of a guide who can point out the most historic sites, as well as the best cafes still serving delicious fare.

Post exploring the Arbat street, proceed to enjoy the Moscow Metro Tour to have an insight into the history, art, myths and legends of Moscow Metro — of one of the biggest and most beautiful metro systems in the world. Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

Night stay in hotel.

Day 03 : Moscow – Murmansk. (Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and dinner)}

Morning transfer to Moscow airport to board flight to Murmansk. Upon arrival in Murmansk, pick up from airport and transfer to hotel. Murmansk Orientation city tour with Lenin Ice Breaker Museum on the way. Check-in to the Igloo. In the evening you will be taken to the tour "Hunting for the Aurora Lights"
Return to the hotel. Dinner at Local Restaurant.
Night stay in Igloo.



Day 04 : Murmansk. {Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & dinner}

Morning check out and proceed for a full day trip to Teriberka, known as old ships graveyard. Also enjoy a tour of Dragon Egg Beach, Sandy Beach, Water Fall. {Lunch in Teriberka}
Evening return to Murmansk. This evening plan for aurora hunting {if not done previous night}.
Night stay in hotel. Dinner at local restaurant



Day 05 : Murmansk. (Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)}

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit to the ethno-park of the Saami people, the oldest Northern nation. Saami tales and shaman rites, national games, feeding reindeer.

Traditional Saami lunch (herbal tea, berry pie, soup and main course).

Transfer to Husky Park (where the dogs are treated and trained professionally): meet over 50 beautiful Siberian huskies and other dogs; **thrilling stories of sledge dogs**; tea stop at the farm with a film of dog races.

{Late night enjoy the Aurora lights, if not done previous night}.

Dinner at local restaurant.

Return to Murmansk for night stay.



Day 06 : Murmansk / St Petersburg.

{Breakfast, Lunch and dinner}

Morning in time transfer to Murmansk airport to board your flight to Saint Petersburg.

Pick up from airport and transfer to hotel. Afternoon start your tour with one of the most beautiful cities – St. Petersburg. St. Petersburg has all the ingredients for an unforgettable travel experience: high art, lavish architecture, wild nightlife, an extraordinary history and rich cultural traditions that have

inspired and nurtured some of the modern world's greatest literature, music, and visual art. From the mysterious twilight of the White Nights to world-beating opera and ballet productions on magical winter evenings, St. Petersburg charms and entices in every season. Our guide meets you at the airport and assists to transfers you to your hotel for check-in. Panoramic City Tour. This tour is a great start to your trip and the best way to get acquainted with all of the city's major highlights. Our professional guide will take you down Nevsky Prospect, St. Petersburg's most famous and vibrant thoroughfare. There you will see some of the city's



most interesting architectural monuments including the Kazan Cathedral and the Winter Palace. You will then proceed to Vasilevsky Island - the area of the city that Peter the Great, originally planned to be the city centre. This island juts out into the Gulf of Finland - reminding you of St. Petersburg's close proximity to the sea and maritime history. The tour will include a visit to the Peter and Paul Fortress - a symbol of St. Petersburg and also the oldest building in the city. While there, you will visit Peter and Paul Cathedral, the burial place of the Russian Tsars from Peter the Great onward. Dinner at Indian Restaurant. Overnight in St. Petersburg hotel.



Day 07 : 8th Nov 25 : Saint Petersburg. (Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and dinner)

After breakfast, we proceed for guided city tour of the Yusupov Palace. Meet your guide in hotel lobby at 10 AM. Set off on your historic tour to discover the grandeur of the Russian Empire from the late 18th to the early 20th century



Overlooking the River Moika, this unique ensemble dates from the 1770s to the early 1900s, and features interiors rightfully described as providing an 'encyclopaedia' of St. Petersburg's aristocratic styles.



Later break for Lunch or Post lunch visit the legendary State Hermitage Museum. The Hermitage. The museum consists of five historical buildings including the Winter Palace - the residence of the Russian Tsars. The museum contains over 3 million pieces of arts with dates ranging from high antiquity to the present day. Among the Hermitage's treasures are artworks by Leonardo da Vinci, Raphael, Titian, Rembrandt, Rubens and more. We will spend 3 hours at the museum, however, to view the collection in its entirety would take almost 15 years, spending

8 hours a day in the museum and taking one minute to examine each exhibit. Night stay in hotel.

Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

Day 08 : Saint Petersburg – Moscow. High speed Train 0630 / 1051 Hrs {Breakfast, Lunch and dinner}

Early morning transfer to SPB train station to board train to Moscow. On arrival, pick up from train station in Moscow and transfer to hotel.

Night stay in hotel.

Day 09 : Moscow - Departure. {Breakfast}

Morning in time transfer to Moscow airport to board your flight back to India.

End of the trip with happy memories.
