### DAY 01: BARCELONA ARRIVAL

### DAY 02: BARCELONA CITY TOUR

See the Sagrada Família. The Sagrada Família is a large unfinished Roman Catholic minor basilica and is a one-of-a-kind temple, for its origins, foundation and purpose. Five generations now have watched the Temple progress in Barcelona. Today, more than 135 years after the laying of the cornerstone, construction continues on the Basilica.

After the fight, the streets are washed down, and the festivities continue with music, parades, and local celebrations. The Tomatina is not just a food fight—it's a unique cultural experience that represents Spain's spirit of joy and togetherness.
